

NINDS Landis Award for Outstanding Mentorship

Nominate a mentor by December 15!

Named for former NINDS Director Dr. Story Landis, this award recognizes those **faculty members who have shown dedication to superior mentorship and training in neuroscience research**. Awardees will receive \$100,000 (direct costs) to support their efforts to foster the career advancement of additional trainees.



2023 Landis Award nominations are now open for senior faculty!

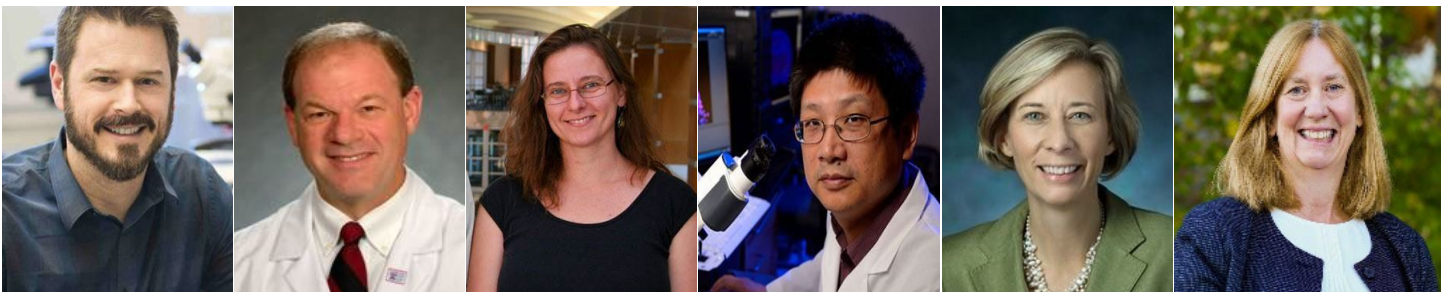
Faculty members who are more than 20 years from the start of their first tenure-track or equivalent faculty positions (i.e., began their position in 2001 or earlier) are eligible.

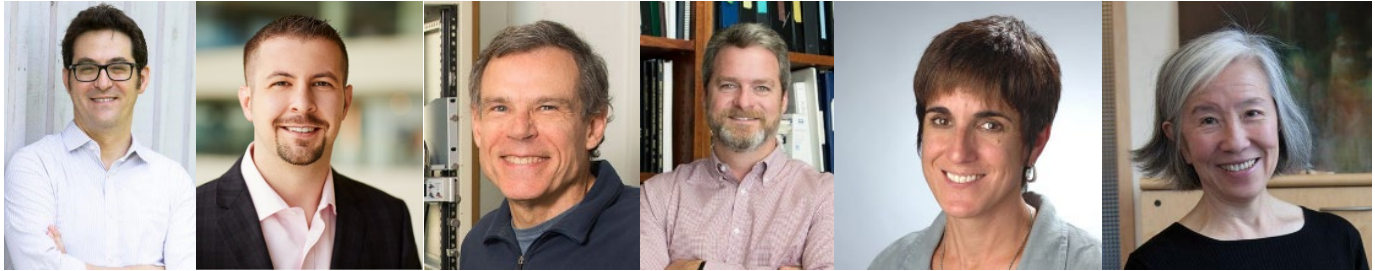
