NIH Extension Policy for Eligibility Window for Pathway to Independence Awards (K99/R00)

NIH provides an extension of the K99 eligibility window for childbirth (see NOT OD-20-011). This is not an extension for the general disruption that accompanies parenting an infant. Those who give birth to a child during the normal K99 eligibility window will be given a one-year extension of eligibility. This 12-month extension for childbirth is in total, not for each child. In addition, the maximum possible extension of K99 eligibility is 12 months — extensions for different justifications are not additive. This one-year extension will automatically apply to individuals giving birth who request an extension and provide the date of childbirth to the Director, NINDS Office of Training and Workforce Development.

While not automatic, individuals can request an extension for other situations (examples below). These requests will be evaluated on a case by case basis.

- Partners of individuals giving birth and individuals adopting children can apply for an extension by justifying the absence from work due to this critical life event.
- Those who have other critical life circumstances (e.g. serious illness [self or close family member], military service, etc.) that result in a prolonged absence from work, can also apply for an extension.

Requests should be submitted via email to the <u>Director, NINDS Office of Training and Workforce</u> <u>Development.</u> Each request is reviewed on a case by case basis.
